

ALREADY IN 6 CITIES WITH CHILDREN

One of our biggest dreams came true in 2024. After Budapest, Szeged, Debrecen, Szombathely and Pécs, **the sixth Amigo city, Miskolc**, was established, so now we can **be by the side of children in all cities in the country with a pediatric oncology center**.

HOW DOES AN AMIGO SESSION LOOK LIKE?

During our hospital visits, our main goal is to help children forget about the hospital environment they are in, their illness and enjoy themselves, so that they can recover at a quicker pace. And what is a better way to achieve this than **through playing**. We can easily incorporate **language learning** into the games, primarily with the help of **our in-house developed card games and workbooks**, as it is also our goal to help the development of children, adapting to their age and current life situation.

IN ADDITION TO OUR HOSPITAL SESSIONS

Although we are not yet able to hold in-person sessions in every pediatric hospital in the country, we do everything **we can to help those children too** who are not in one of our **6 Amigo cities**. As a result of all our efforts, in 2024 **we brought joy to and cheered up more than 20,000 children** with our visits, gifts or through other type of support.

We delivered the third edition of our Adventure Box - KALANDobOZZ to 2,000 sick children in 24 hospitals

We distributed 11,779 LEGO sets to hospitalised and disadvantaged children

We facilitated 'Santa Claus Day' programs and activities in several hospital wards.

We helped children in oncology departments and in camps



HOSPITAL WARDS

In addition to oncology departments, our volunteers also hold sessions in many other hospital departments, including **orthopedics, neurology, rehabilitation, psychiatric, surgical, pediatric cardiology, burn and internal medicine departments**, to name but a few.



In 2024, we expanded with a total of 4 new hospital teams, so in total 20 Amigo teams visited children across the country at the same time.

WITH THE CHILDREN DURING THE HOLIDAY SEASON

In 2024, the Amigos held several **afternooon sessions for children in the hospital during holidays**. In the spring semester, we made the children's days more joyful on the occasion of Easter and Children's Day, and in the fall semester, we brought the magic of festivities inside the hospital walls with **Santa Claus Day and Christmas sessions**. We held interactive programs in a total of four hospital wards, including the Kecskemét hospital. And it goes without saying that playful language learning also played an important part.



IN-HOUSE DEVELOPED MATERIALS SUPPORTING PLAYFUL LEARNING

In 2024, we prepared a total of **13 different in-house developed and edited workbooks and 4 different card games**, which aim to spread knowledge as well as develop skills, while also improving the memory, logical thinking and creativity.

In addition to using them in hospital sessions, we also **donated our workbooks to 37 institutions in Hungary**, where the Amigos are not present personally - so that children can also explore the world while learning playfully through stories and games in the booklets.

This year, we introduced two new workbooks supplementing our hospital boxes: "*Let's explore the United Kingdom together*" and "*Let's explore the Portugal together*" activity booklets.



WE HELP WITH OUR IN-HOUSE DEVELOPED LANGUAGE LEARNING TOOLS

Our hospital sessions are supported by our **dedicated hospital boxes** filled with **engaging tools and games**. They offer logic-, memory- and skill-building games for all ages. Moreover, our in-house developed 13 workbooks and 4 card games also contribute to the language learning experience.





WE HAVE PUBLISHED OUR SECOND BOOK

BRINGING THE AMIGO EXPERIENCE TO MORE CHILDREN

Even though we are not yet able to be present personally in all pediatric hospitals in Hungary, we would like to help children who are hospitalized in a city outside of the reach of Amigos.


The purpose of the donated toys and games is to give these children a glimpse into the experience of Amigo activities and to bring joy to those who are spending the holidays in the hospital.



In 2024, we distributed more than 11 000 LEGO sets in hospitals on Children's Day and Christmas, covering nearly 80% of the hospitalized children in Hungary. During the gift-giving, we also involved other NGOs within the Appy Nonprofit community in the project, so we were able to make a total of 11 779 children happier.

ADVENTURE BOX 2024

We managed to implement the Adventure Box - KALANDobOZZ project this year as well, also with the aim of bringing the Amigo experience to as many children in hospitals as possible. That's why we have gathered everything that makes in-person Amigo sessions so magical in this special box: fun, skill-development and gamified-learning.



WE HANDED OUT ADVENTURE BOXES TO **2000** CHILDREN
IN **24** HOSPITALS IN HUNGARY

We created two versions of the Adventure Box - KALANDobOZZ this year, one for kindergarteners and another for school-aged children. We adapted the content to the needs of each age group.

The children's mood improved significantly as a result of the experience provided by the box.


Sick children treated in hospital can often feel lonely or isolated. Our presence helps them escape the hospital environment and have company, supporting their mental and emotional well-being.


OUR IMPACT IN 2024



OUR VALUE LIES IN OUR AMIGO VOLUNTEERS

The foundation of our organization is build up by our university student volunteers, the Amigos, who visit the children in hospitals. Without them, we would not be able to function. Therefore, for a balanced operation, it is important to take into account that **an Amigo stays with us for an average of 2 years**, thanks to the retaining power of the community, so we have to take care of recruiting new volunteers every year. We recruit volunteers once a semester, adapted to university schedule and students' often changing free-time. In the recruitment process we all work together to select the most suitable candidates for our teams and community.


WHAT CHARACTERIZES AN AMIGO VOLUNTEER?



OUR COMMUNITY IS GROWING YEAR BY YEAR

In addition to helping children, we also find it very important to **encourage social responsibility among young people**, so taking into account the capacity of hospitals and sustaining our solid community, we try to provide as many applicants as possible with the opportunity to volunteer with us.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT AND COMMUNITY BUILDING

Before starting the hospital sessions, **every Amigo needs to attend a full-day training, the so called 'Amigo School'**, where our experienced volunteers prepare the new joiners for the hospital sessions and to the **situations they may face with children in hospitals** and teach them how to respond to them correctly. Apart from this, **child protection, Amigo values, developmental psychology, internal communication and the background of the organization** are also discussed. And, of course, team building cannot be left out during the day either.



AMIGOS ACADEMY

We organize Amigos Academy occasions several times within a semester, which are additional training opportunities for Amigo volunteers. Their goal is to prepare our volunteers as much as possible to the hospital sessions, therefore, we always choose topics of actual relevance. These sessions are usually facilitated by our former volunteers or invited professionals. In 2024, we organized the following lectures, among others:

-Virág Bölecz -
Alumni Amigo and project manager gave a presentation on the basics of project management and how volunteers can utilise such skill and knowledge in their work in the foundation's supporting teams.

-Éva Fényszárosi-
Alumni Amigo, an applied health psychologist and Grief Processing Method® Specialist, gave a lecture on grief and its appearance in children's lives, as well as on how we can communicate with children about grief and death.

-Matyi-Bokolosz Kynthia-
A psychologist from Mindset Psychology shared her knowledge about assertive communication and its application when it comes to communicating with parents of the children in the hospitals.

TRAINING AND PSYCHOEDUCATIONAL CAMP

Our key community-building event is our Training Camp, organised annually at the end of the summer. Here, in addition to team-building programs, invited experts provide training for volunteers on a wide variety of topics.

Organizational transparency is an important principle for us, which is why Sára Forgács-Fábián, Founder and Chair of the Board of Trustees of the Amigos for Children Foundation, held a workshop on the initial phase and development of Amigos as an organisation. The Amigos have always been at the center of the organisation, as without them achieving the mission would not be possible. Transparency is essential, therefore the volunteers need to be made aware of the issues affecting the organization.

In order for the Amigo volunteers to be **mentally prepared both in their private lives and during hospital sessions**, we also organized our annual psychoeducational camp. This year, the professional and psychoeducational camps were held simultaneously, where the volunteers, with professional support from Mindset Psychology, worked on topics such as self-acceptance and relaxation.

HOSPITAL TEAM MEETINGS

The **hospital team meeting** is one of the key events in the life of a hospital team. These monthly recurring events serve as an opportunity to **share experiences related to hospital sessions and community**. This is a secure space to share **any positive and negative** experience with peer Amigo volunteers. These meetings are facilitated by the hospital coordinators in each Amigo city, who then discusses the more difficult cases that require more attention with the Amigo responsible for Children's Happiness.

Hospital meetings often take place in a café or even in nature in the form of a picnic. These gatherings always involve informal/catch-up conversations and community building games after the experience sharing part.



FOR THE MENTAL HEALTH OF THE AMIGOS

Our volunteers may encounter **difficult situations** during their hospital sessions, so we provide them with a **psychological safety net** in the form of **3 sessions of supportive conversations**, where they can receive professional guidance about challenges in the hospital or any issues within the community.



This professional safety net has been provided by **the experts at Mindset Psychology since 2023**. They help our volunteers overcome difficulties and support them in effectively continuing their work in the Amigos community.

In addition, lectures on psychological topics and workshops focused on self-discovery are held by them for volunteers.

Special thanks to the Ünnepek Áruháza for the balloons, which added cheer to the evening, and to Nikolett Forray, who made everything possible!



OUR BOARD OF TRUSTEES

OUR AWARDS

On World Volunteer Day, we participated in the awards ceremony organised by the Family Friendly Hungary Center. Although we did not win the public vote, our nomination still brought meaningful support as the Foundation received a 1,000,000 forint contribution for its work.

These figures may differ in part from those in the report prepared according to accounting principles due to accruals, for example.

Donations in kind and services (57.9%):
Craft tools, board games, advice and other material and service offerings.


Free-use corporate grants (5.2%):
Corporate support provided to cover unspecified costs.

Other income (0.5%): sales of logoed products

Restricted-use corporate subsidies (24.1%):
Corporate support provided to cover specific costs or support obtained through a tender.

Interest income (0.8%):
Interest income from fixed-term deposits.

Private donations (11.5%):
Individual donors (regular/one-time), private donations, including the 1% campaign.



OUR TOTAL EXPENSES: 261.8 MILLION HUF

Operating wages (13.7%):


Annual salary and contribution costs of our employees responsible for operations, administration, fundraising and communication, and management.

Operation (2.6%):

Postage, logistics, accounting, VAT, telephone bill, bank charges, website costs, tangible assets, office costs, other operating costs.

Voluntary community (2.6%):

Camps, admissions, gifts, training, other programs, tools organized for Amigos, which aim to build, maintain and develop the community. This also includes expenses related to non-Amigo volunteers (office volunteers, packing helpers, advisory volunteers, etc.).



Helping children (79.2%):

(direct costs of our mission) Games, supplies for classes, hospital boxes, contact cards, volunteer name cards, therapist costs that arose in connection with our main activity, our other projects, such as KALANDobOZZ, donation of LEGO sets, Amigos Book. This also includes the salary costs of the staff organizing the main activity.

Marketing and communication (1.9%):

Online and offline advertisements, publications, merchandise.

Our core principle is that when we make a promise, we keep it. To maintain sustainable and predictable operations, we follow a conservative reserve strategy so we can continue to support children even in more challenging economic conditions.

CLOSING THOUGHTS

We are very grateful and proud that in 2024, **a total of 281 Amigos visited and supported children in 6 cities and 20 hospital units across the country**. On our 10th anniversary, a big dream came true: Amigos sessions were launched in Miskolc, thus arriving in every city with a pediatric oncology center in Hungary.

In 2025, besides continuous growth, we continue to work on reliable and predictable operation and sessions, because
